The Department of Defense recently expanded the Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts (MyCAA) for military spouses of active duty and activated Guard and Reserve service members. Eligible military spouses worldwide may receive up to \$6,000 of financial assistance to help pay for licenses, certifications and education in high growth, high demand portable career fields. MyCAA provides up to \$6,000 of financial assistance for eligible spouses directly to participating schools or other programs to pay for expenses such as post-secondary education and training, tuition, licensing, and credentialing fees.
